

# **COBHC Trainee Recruitment Information**

## **Who is eligible to apply?**

- ❖ CADC, Masters in Counseling, and Masters in Social Work *students* in field placement programs in Central Oregon, or from distance programs but living in and completing field experience with the region.
- ❖ *Associates* completing their residency or fellowship.

## **How do I apply?**

## **Will I get paid to be a trainee?**

- ❖ Yes! A \$250 monthly stipend will be provided to trainees in urban field placements.
- ❖ A \$350 monthly stipend will be provided to trainees working in the following prioritized regions: Rural, frontier, or any clinical setting where the trainee will work with children and families at least 75% of their time.
  - ❖ This competitive incentive can be valued at \$20 to \$29 per hour for (approximately) 3 hours of weekly education related consortium work.

## **What if my training site is not a COBHC member?**

- ❖ The COBHC will work with your training site to get them vetted as a member.

## **If I am a student who is also employed by or being paid for my internship time, can I also receive the consortium stipend?**

- ❖ Trainees would be able to receive the stipend funds from the consortium regardless of being paid by their field placement site.
  - ❖ \*There may be some exceptions, these will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

## **Will I be expected to complete the required consortium hours in addition to the weekly 13-16 field hours?**

- ❖ The field placement site would be expected to allow the student to complete the consortium requirements within their own specific requirements.
